Home Care Plan





Home Checklist:

- ☐ Set home temperature to at least 68° F to 70° F.
- ☐ Close heat vents and shut doors in rooms that are not used.
- ☐ Add caulk, weather strips or plastic film around drafty windows.
- ☐ Change furnace filter and check to make sure furnace is working.
- Clean debris from fireplaces and chimneys.

- ☐ Reverse ceiling fans to circulate warm air.
- ☐ Patch foundation and attic holes.
- ☐ Turn off and insulate outdoor faucets. Blow out outdoor sprinkler systems.
- ☐ Check all space heaters and review safety features.
- ☐ Keep ice melt, sand or kitty litter nearby for treating icy surfaces.



Items you may consider installing include a digital thermostat in the home to help regulate indoor temperatures and automatic outdoor lighting that turns on/off at dusk/dawn.

Personal Care Checklist:

- ☐ Place throw blankets on couches, chairs and other easy-to-reach areas.
- ☐ Fill a basket with extra socks, gloves, hats and scarves.
- Add a thin layer of clothing, like long underwear, close to the body to wick away moisture.
- ☐ Dress in layers to make it easy to add or remove clothing as body temperature changes.
- ☐ Review all medications for any temperature-lowering effect.
- ☐ Stock water and nonperishable foods in case of emergency.
